Please note on your calendars a schedule change. Due to flooding at Rolling Thunder Raceway the NHRA Division 5 Junior Dragster Division Race has been moved to Eddyville Raceway Park on the weekend of August 5-7, 2011. Details on the next page.

Motorized Pit Vehicles (NEW NHRA POLICY)

Due to insurance regulations, new this season at ALL Division 5 NHRA racetracks, it is a requirement that all Motorized Pit Vehicles (Scooters, Sprees, Golf Carts, 4-Wheelers, etc) be registered at the Racetrack in order to be operated at the track. The cost is \$10, a registration form must be completed to keep on file at the track, and a sticker will be issued to affix to the pit vehicle. This Pit Vehicle Registration is **not optional** and is **mandated** by the NHRA. Complete details and forms are on the website www.cordovadrag.com and at each track. Mini-bikes, ATV's, golf carts and related vehicles can ONLY be operated by licensed drivers. Each vehicle must display the car number of the team/driver it is with. Reckless driving of any type will NOT be tolerated, and the team/driver will be verbally warned for the first offense and the second offense will result in a disqualification from the racing event. These types of vehicles must be operated in a safe manner at all times, as mandated by our insurance company. No such vehicle is to be operated in the restricted area of the pits, EVER! This will be strictly enforced!!

Drive Slow in the Pits

No Minors are allowed to drive pit vehicles of any kind. No roller-blades please. No motorized traffic 1 hour after racing is completed. Please observe "Quiet Time".
